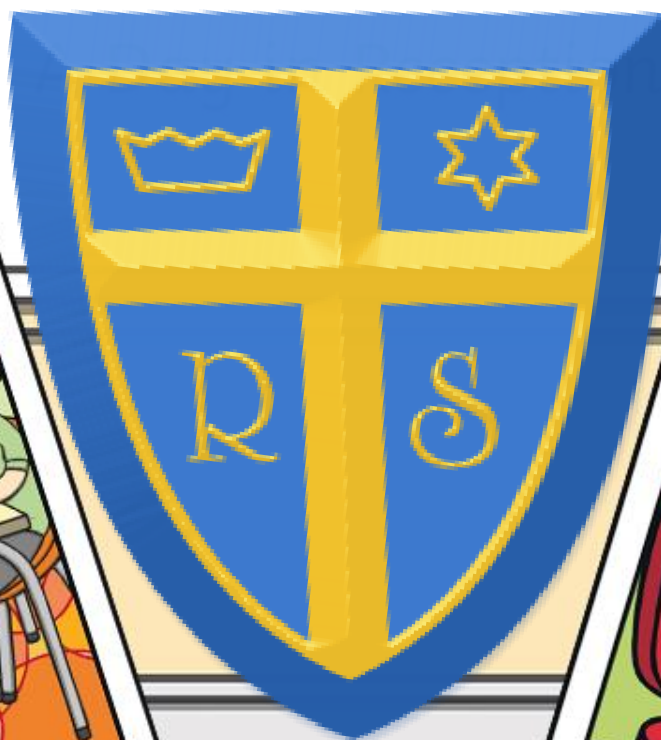


Starting School

Sometimes, me or Mrs Wilson might ask you to come and do a special job with us too.



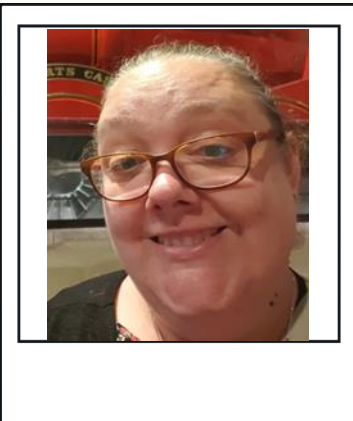
Good morning!

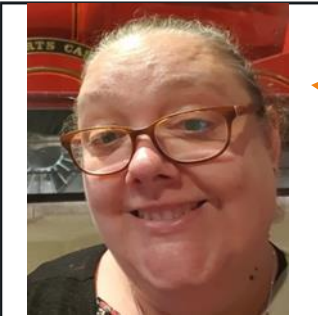




Our next job is to do the register. We sit quietly on the carpet for this special job. I will read out a list of all the children in our class to see who is in school today using our big screen.



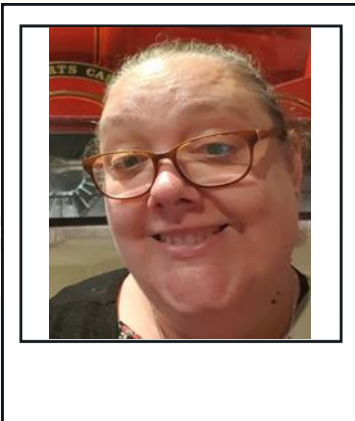
