School Uniform Policy

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL CLOTHING USED AT SCHOOL ARE NAMED. THIS HELPS US ANY LOST ITEMS TO THEIR OWNERS

The Rosary School colour is navy blue. Acceptance of a place at this school means agreeing to the uniform guidelines of the Rosary School. The uniform gives a visible sign of belonging to the school and helps the development of a community spirit whilst also ensuring equality of status in dress. Pupils are expected to look smart at all times and dress to work. Year-round school uniform

- Black shoes
- White or grey socks or navy tights

- Pair of wellington boots for outdoor wear

Optional Summer Uniform

- Plain white polo shirt
- Navy skirt or shorts, or, blue and white check dress
- Grey shorts
- Black shoes or sensible closed toe white or blue sandals with backs
- White or grey socks

PE Kit

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain navy sweatshirt (for outdoors)
- Trainers

Swimming Lessons

- Swimming costume or trunks and towel

Football Club and Competitions

- Pupils who participate in football club or competitions will need football boots and shin pads

Younger children

It is especially important that younger children can put their shoes on and take them off independently. Please ensure that shoes and trainers have Velcro fastenings to aid with this.
