Reading at home

Reading at home is vitally important. Please aim for a minimum of 4 times a week and record your child's reading in their reading record. Reading books will be changed every **Monday**. Please ensure that your child's reading book and record are kept in their school bag.

Homework

- Read, Write Inc. Spellings

We are reaching the end of learning the spelling rules within Read Write Inc Spelling. For the first three weeks of term, the children will continue to learn a new spelling rule during their session on a Monday and be tested the following week. Once we have completed all the units (by Tuesday 4th May), we will then revise and practice the rules we've learnt this term but there will not be a weekly test.

- Rainbow Spellings

The children will be continuing with their rainbow spellings and be tested each Thursday. If they complete all of the spellings, they will be tested at random on a few identified colours each week.

Times Table Rockstars!
