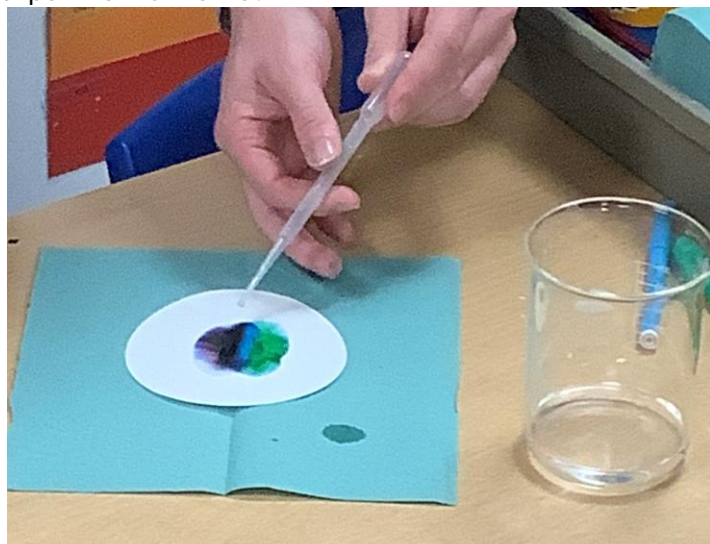

A Spotlight on... Year 4 & 5

On Wednesday the children in Year 4 and Year 5 played host to two visiting science teachers from St. Peter's High School. They carried out practical experiments with the children, including the effect of exercise on respiration rates and pulse. In chemistry we conducted a chromatography test on the colours present in pen ink and in the process created multicoloured 'wigs' for our paper troll-dolls. Finally in physics we attempted to see if soap bubbles could be moved using static electricity. This meant rubbing our hair vigorously with inflated balloons. There was a lot of fun and some serious learning too. Perhaps you could replicate the balloon experiment at home?
